

BE AGGRESSIVE WITH THIS!

"The Church Is Like A Hospital. Everyone There Is Sick But Not All Patients Are Responding To Treatment!"

Intro: The believers at Corinth were a mess! Corinth was fertile ground for the Gospel but also *dangerous ground for immature believers*. Paul had to correct them concerning *fellowship* (1:10-11=DIVISIONS), *holiness*, (5:1-5=*SEXUAL IMMORALITY & LACK OF CHURCH DISCIPLINE*), and *doctrine* (15=*THE RESURRECTION*). Why the strong, *AGGRESSIVE ADMONITION!?* Because MESS that hinders *The Mission Of Christ, The Fellowship of Believers and Our Calling As Ambassadors MUST BE DEALT WITH AGGRESSIVELY!*

HOW We Need To BE AGGRESSIVE WITH THIS! By Definition

- AGGRESSIVE=To be in a state of "combative readiness" [Warfare Ready]
- AGGRESSIVE=To be "driven" by Holy Ghost "Energy" and "Initiative" [Will Surrendered]
- AGGRESSIVE=To be "emphatic" [OBVIOUS] in "intent" [Works/Fruit Focused]

4 WAYS WE MUST BE AGGRESSIVE WITH THIS!

- 1. *BE AGGRESSIVELY*______ (vs. 13 "*Watch ye...*")-Stay awake with the intent to watch.
 - Protect *your house* and *The House Of God* by being on constant guard against the enemy (1 Peter 5:8).
- 2. BE AGGRESSIVELY In Your (vs. 13 "...stand fast in the faith...")-<u>Stand Your Ground</u> on The Truth no matter the cost!
 - Consistent Obedience to Who and what you believe is Living Active Faith (Acts 20:22-24, 21:10-14).
- **3.** *BE AGGRESSIVELY* ______ For Your Actions (vs. 13 "...*quit you like men..."* [*BE COURAGEOUS; ACT LIKE A MAN OR A RESPONSIBLE ADULT*])-Be accountable, correctable and teachable.

Spiritual maturity will counter irresponsibility (Hebrews 5:11-14=*SPIRITUALLY LETHARGIC, LAZY OR INDIFFERENT*)

4. BE AGGRESSIVELY Active In ______ (vs. 13 "...be

strong." [BECOME POWERFUL])-Become spiritually stronger beyond the average or expectation by putting in *spiritual* work!!!

- Pray Without ceasing (1 Thessalonians 5:17)
- Read/Study/Meditate on His Word diligently (2 Timothy 2:15)
- Serve The Lord with gladness (Psalm 100:2)
- Give As The Lord has prospered you (1 Corinthians 16:2)
- Worship The Lord in spirit and in truth (John 4:24).
