Intro: The Gospel of Jesus Christ is NOT a one-time experience. It's a *LIFETIME experience*. The Full Benefits Of The Gospel are unlimited in range and power, and helps believers deal with challenges (expected and unexpected) and overcome them!

The Theological Benefits Of The Gospel

- 🌐 **Propitiation**-The giving of Christ Life as a ransom for yours
- 🌐 **Redemption**-Purchased out of the slave market of sin and set free.
- 🌐 **Regeneration**-To become a new creature by receiving a divine nature thus, reflecting God's character
- 🌐 **Justification**-The believing sinner is declared righteous by God The Judge.
- 🌐 **Sanctification**-Supernaturally rescued from the disease of sin and conformed to the image of Christ.

The Practical Benefits Of The Gospel

- 🌐 Your life is transformed for the better
- 🌐 Truth is revealed as absolute and evident
- 🌐 You no longer have to fight and figure out life on your own
- 🌐 Peace and Joy like you've never experienced before is available to you.
- 🌐 Relationships are enriched, or sometimes exited.

3 FOUNDATIONAL FULL BENEFITS OF THE GOSPEL

1. The **FULL BENEFITS** Of The _____ Of Scripture (vs. 1-2 “**called [a request to which refusal is not an option]...separated unto the Gospel of God...Which He had promised afore...in the Holy Scriptures...**”)-The Gospel Fulfilled Scripture and Supernaturally Fulfilled us.
 - a. We were *spiritually birthed* into relationship by The Word Of God (James 1:18)
 - b. We’ve been specifically assigned to *one thing* and *away from another* by The Word Of God (1 Thessalonians 4:7).

2. The **FULL BENEFITS** Of The _____, _____ Savior (vs. 3-4 “**Concerning His Son Jesus Christ...made...according to the flesh[HIS HUMILIATION]...declared to be the Son of God with power [HIS EXALTATION]...by the resurrection from the dead.**”)-The Gospel Supernaturally Empowers our lives.
 - a. Christ *Humiliation* in the flesh paid our sin debt with \$0 deductible (*i.e., what we paid!*) (Ephesians 2:8).
 - b. Christ *Exaltation* released the Power of the indwelling Holy Spirit (John 16:7=*THE COMFORTER* & Luke 24:49=*ENDUED WITH POWER*).

3. The **FULL BENEFITS** Of His _____ And _____ For Us (vs. 5-6 “**...we have received grace [GOOD WILL AND FAVOR]...apostleship ...for His Name...the called of Christ.**”)-The Gospel provides *mission* and *motive* for our lives.
 - a. The *mission* is to exalt HIM (John 15:8=*BEARING MUCH FRUIT* & Romans 15:5-6=*BE LIKEMINDED/ONE MIND AND ONE MOUTH GLORIFY God*)
 - b. The *motive* is HIS Love that lifted me (Ephesians 2:4-5)!
